UNAUTHORISED WALL AT MILL FARMHOUSE, 87 MIDDLEWATCH, SWAVESEY The Planning Enforcement Sub-Committee was minded to issue and serve an Enforcement Notice requiring demolition of the unauthorised wall at Mill Farmhouse, 87 Middlewatch, Swavesey, with a compliance period of 28 days, subject to the owners of the wall not having demolished it voluntarily by 8 April 2010. Reason: The wall is considered to harm the setting of the Grade II listed building by virtue of its materials and detailing and, as such, is contrary to Policy CH/4 of the South Cambridgeshire Local Development Control Policies DPD 2007 (DPD)
