- 1. HERITAGE GUARDIANSHIP SITES: LANDBEACH TITHE BARN, EAST HATLEY CHURCH AND SAWSTON TANNERY DRYING SHED**
The Economic Development Portfolio Holder **ENDORSED** the updated Landbeach Tithe Barn project plan and the list of trustees and their commitment.

Other Options Considered: It was noted that an alternative was to sell the Landbeach Tithe Barn with residential planning consent. This was seen as a fall-back position should the transfer to the Trust not be achieved.

Reason For Decision: To keep the Portfolio Holder informed regarding Heritage sites, and enable related activities to continue.

- 2. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT/GROWTH STRATEGY REFRESH (2016-2020)**
The Economic Development Portfolio Holder **APPROVED** the refresh of the Economic Development/Growth Strategy 2016 – 2020.

Other Options Considered: To not update the Strategy or to agree a completely new Strategy instead of a refresh.

Reason For Decision: The report seeks to acknowledge economic actions achieved through the economic strategy of 2010-2015 and seeks to determine future delivery for the period 2016 – 2020.
