EXECUTIVE DECISIONS TAKEN SINCE WEDNESDAY 7 JUNE 2017



In accordance with the Access to Information Procedure Rules in Part 4 of the Council's Constitution, any executive decision shall be published normally within five days of being made. That record will bear the date on which it is published and will specify that the decision will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of 5 working days after the publication of the decision, unless called in for review by the Chairman of the Scrutiny and Overview Committee or by any five other councillors.

A list of decisions currently within the call-in period is available on the Council's website.

The call in procedure is set out in full in <u>Part 4 of the Council's Constitution</u>, 'Scrutiny and Overview Committee Procedure Rules'.

5. Appointment to Greater Cambridge City Deal Joint Assembly

The Leader has appointed Councillor Grenville Chamberlain as one of the Council's three representatives on the Greater Cambridge City Deal Joint Assembly. He replaces Councillor Tim Wotherspoon who remains on the Assembly but as a County Councillor.

Please note that as this decision is an appointment made by the Leader and so cannot be called-in.

6. Community Chest Grant (Linton Action for Youth)

The Finance and Staffing Portfolio Holder **AGREED** to award Linton Action for Youth a further £40 towards the repair of the roof at the drop in centre, which facilitates youth work.

This decision was first published on Monday 12 June and so the deadline for call-in is Monday 19 June. If not called-in this decision can be implemented on Tuesday 20 June.




