1. WILLINGHAM AND OVER PARISH BOUNDARY REVIEW

The Committee

RECOMMENDED THAT COUNCIL

- A) Agree the alternative boundary, as shown on the green line in the attached map, less the red cross hatched area.
- B) Make a request to the Local Government Boundary Commission for England (LGBCE) to re-align the County Council boundary along the new parish boundary.

Other Options Considered: To recommend to Council no change to the parish boundary, or

Recommend to Council the "First Proposed New Boundary" as shown in Appendix J, or Recommend to Council "Second Proposed New Boundary" as shown in Appendix J, or Recommend to Council an alternative boundary.

To recommend to Council to make a request to the LGBCE to re-align the County Council boundary along the new parish boundary, or Recommend to Council not to make a request to the LGBCE to re-align the County Council boundary along the new parish boundary.

Reason For Decision: This recommendation:

- Provides an easily identifiable boundary that is likely to remain.
- Reflects the views of affected persons.
- Reflects community identity on the ground.
- Only affects land necessary for good governance.
