Thursday 9 August: *Times:* <u>People Power: Residents to be given direct say in Local</u> <u>Government</u>

Ministers are proposing that local authorities use online polls and citizens juries to give residents a direct say in decisions, such as to approve housing developments and the selling of assets. Councils in six areas will take part in trials over the next 12 months.

Thursday 9 August: *Guardian:* <u>Tory MP Breaks Rank on Northampton County Council Crisis</u> The Government needs to urgently "learn the lessons" from the pressures facing Northamptonshire County Council if they are to prevent more councils facing similar funding issues, Conservative MP and LGA Vice President Andrew Lewer has warned.

Friday 10 August: *BBC Online:* <u>Northamptonshire County Council approves cuts plan</u> The Government has announced it will abandon plans to place councils in charge of ring-fenced funding for emergency accommodation.

Friday 10 August: *Independent:* <u>Government U-turn on supported housing plans</u> The Government has announced it will abandon plans to place councils in charge of ring-fenced funding for emergency accommodation.

Sunday 12 August: *Observer:* <u>Third of UK's Universal Credit claimants hit by deductions</u> A third of people receiving Universal Credit payments are having debts such as rent arrears, council tax bills and utilities deducted from payments before receiving them, a series of freedom of information requests have found.

View Planning Applications



To view the list of planning applications that have recently been submitted to the Council, please visit the authority's on-line <u>Planning Application Search</u>. Once the page has loaded, you can use the <u>Search</u> <u>option</u> to set your own criteria of parish, area and date range.

The system will provide a range of information on current and decided applications since 1948, including a brief description of the development, reference number, decision and the date of decision. More recent applications show the name and telephone number of the council officer who is dealing with the application.

Search results are presented in a collection of pages, the number of which depends on the number of results your search produces. There are navigation tools to allow you to browse your results.

EXECUTIVE DECISIONS TAKEN SINCE WEDNESDAY 8 AUGUST 2018



In accordance with the <u>Access to Information Procedure</u> <u>Rules in Part 4 of the Council's Constitution</u>, any executive decision shall be published normally within five days of being made. That record will bear the date on which it is published and will specify that the decision will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of 5 working days after the publication of the decision, unless called in for review by the Chairman of the Scrutiny and Overview Committee or by any five other councillors.

A list of decisions currently within the call-in period is available on the Council's website.

The call in procedure is set out in full in <u>Part 4 of the Council's Constitution, 'Scrutiny and</u> <u>Overview Committee Procedure Rules'</u>.
