A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire: major improvements

Construction work on the new A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon scheme is underway. We are currently carrying out a variety of tasks for which we need to close lanes or carriageways on the A1, A14 and some local roads at times, usually overnight between 8pm and 6am, unless otherwise stated. A clearly signed diversion route will always be in place for closures.

For this week, the planned closures are:

Full closures

Monday 29th October to Friday 2nd November (five nights)

A1 northbound between Buckden and Alconbury

Vehicles will travel east on the A428, north on the A1198, west on the A14 and then north on the A14 link road to re-join the A1

A1 southbound between Alconbury and Buckden

Vehicles will be diverted south on the A14 link road, then east on the A14, south on the A1198 and west on the A428 to re-join the A1

- M11 junction 14 exit slip
- A428 eastbound Madingley to A14 eastbound Milton J33

Motorway traffic will travel south on the M11, east on A505 and north on A11 to re-join the A14. Non motorway traffic will be diverted on local roads through Cambridge.

A14 westbound between Six Mile Bottom J36 and Girton J31

Motorway traffic will travel south on the A11, west on the A505 and then north on the M11.

Non motorway traffic will diverted on local roads through Cambridge

Monday 29th October to Thursday 1st November (four nights)

A14 westbound junction 28 exit slip (Cambridge Services)

Wednesday 31st October to Friday 2nd November (three nights)

Buckingway Road

Friday 2nd 9pm to Sunday 4th November 6pm

Connington Road

Saturday 3rd 6am to Monday 5th 5am

Oakington Road

Saturday 3rd and Sunday 4th 6am to 6pm

 Buckden Road, Brampton Road, A1 southbound Brampton exit and entry slips

Vehicles wishing to access Brampton village from the A1 southbound will be required to exit the A1 at Brampton Hut, leave the A14 at junction 22 and enter Brampton via the B1514. To travel south from Brampton village, the diversion will be the reverse.

Saturday 3rd (one night)

A14 eastbound between St Ives J26 and Bar Hill J29

Strategic traffic will be diverted south on the A1198, then east on the A428 to re-join the A14.

Access for local traffic will be maintained between the hard closure and the strategic diversion

Sunday 4th (one night)

A14 westbound between Girton J31 and Fenstanton J27

Vehicles will be diverted west on the A428 then north on the A1198 to re-join the A14 at Godmanchester

Local access will be maintained between the strategic diversion and the hard closure

- M11 northbound J14 to A14 westbound
- A1307 outbound
