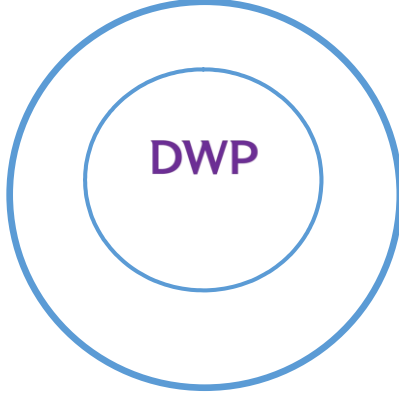


UC replaces 6 benefits

Housing Benefit is estimated at £11.9M UC is Highest Risk to HRA



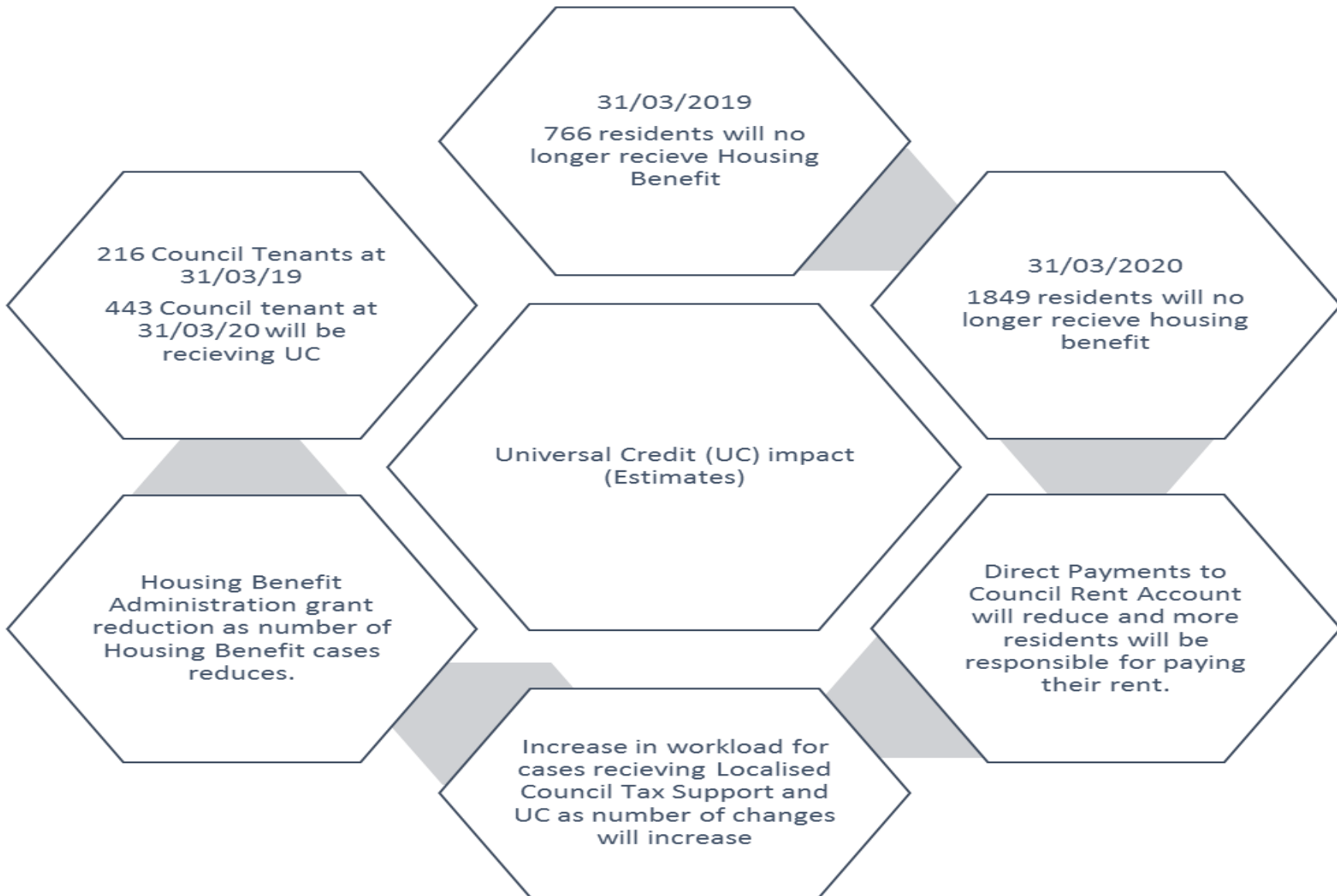

Universal Credit (UC) impact (Estimates)

Direct Payments to Council Rent Account will reduce and more residents will be responsible for paying their rent.

Increase in workload for cases receiving Localised Council Tax Support and UC as number of changes will increase

Housing Benefit Administration grant reduction as number of Housing Benefit cases reduces.
