Locations of fire safety and other safety equipment subject to change in accordance with the requirements of the responsible authorities or following a risk assessment.

Any detail shown on the plan that is not required by the licensing plans regulations is indicative only, and subject to change at any time.

Food will be available throughout the day with waiter/waitress service during peak times.

Prevention of crime and disorder

CCTV will be installed, operated and maintained in agreement with the Police. The system will enable frontal identification of every person entering the premises. The system will record in real time and operate whilst the premises are open for licensable activities. The recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days.


