- The above budget is assuming that there will be 7 schemes in total. The 6 villages; Papworth, Sawston, Thriplow, Gamlingay, Willingham, Whittlesford and making the villages along the A428 and A1198 as one scheme
- The costs are based on each scheme supporting 20 older people in total
- The weekly cost for the service user has been worked out at £10 per week.
 This has been worked out at 26 weeks for 15 people on the schemes and the remaining 26 weeks at 20 people on the schemes and then reduced the total figure by 10% to allow for schemes not being up to numbers.
- The salaries have been calculated on the living wage from the 1st April and also include the salary to appoint a part time Team Leader to oversee the schemes
