

A14 Cambridge to Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire: major improvements

We are currently carrying out finishing works for which we need to close lanes or carriageways on the A1, A14 and some local roads at times, usually overnight between 9pm and 6am, unless otherwise stated. A clearly signed diversion route will always be in place for closures.

For this week, the planned closures are:

Full closures

Friday 6 9pm to Monday 9 6am (57 hours)

- B1514 Brampton Road between Scholars Avenue and Edison Bell Way

Vehicles on the Huntingdon town centre side will be diverted onto the ring road, St Peters Road to A141 west to Brampton / Brampton Racecourse junction and into Brampton via B1514.

Vehicles on the Brampton side of the closure will follow this diversion in reverse.

Please note, pedestrian & cyclist access will remain via the northern footpath on Brampton Road

Saturday 7 6am to Monday 9 6am (48 hours)

- A14 westbound Godmanchester junction 23 entry slip

Vehicles will be diverted east on the A1307 to Swavesey and join the A14 westbound at Swavesey junction 24. Vehicles can also travel south on A1198 to A428 westbound, A1 northbound and join the A14 via Brampton Hut at New Ellington junction 21

Please be aware there will be 2-way traffic lights on the A1198 at this location to facilitate the surfacing and lining work
