This body comprises 4 District Councillors, 2 (3 from April 2006) persons independent of the Council (selected following advertisement) and 2 (3 from April 2006) Parish Councillors from parishes within the district. It promotes and maintains high standards of conduct within the District Council and Parish Councils, through the Members' Code of Conduct. Standards Committee meetings are open to the public, although deliberations may be held in private session.
