

Comments from Impington Parish Council

First Councillor:

“I am mainly concerned that the 3 parking spaces, plus the sign, right next to the Anglia alleyway obscures exiting traffic. Delivery vans often park haphazardly near here, and there's a bus stop a couple of metres away. At peak hours, the pavement is heavily used by schoolkids of all ages on bikes, scooters, etc. whilst on the road, there is dense traffic (with lots of vehicle movements) including the Citi 7, and soon the Guided buses, and juggernauts delivering to the nearby cardboard factory. Optimum visibility at all side roads is essential. The sign also blocks approaching pedestrians from the view of drivers coming out of the Anglia Fireplace premises.”

Second Councillor:

“I would have to highlight the prejudice to Road Safety CH/8 as stated in the Planning policy section of the supporting document, especially as a vehicle has already hit the sign when apparently accessing the site.”
