



Recurring issues requiring partnership support	Appears in:
Need for measures to reduce traffic speed within villages.	13 out of 24 plans
Need for better police presence within the community / more community interaction with police.	12 out of 24 plans
Improvements to (and creation of) new cycleways, linking villages/towns.	12 out of 24 plans
Improvements to public transport provision, particularly evening/late night provision.	12 out of 24 plans
Improvement to youth facilities.	11 out of 24 plans
Set-up or re-invigoration of Neighbourhood Watch Schemes.	9 out of 24 plans
Provision of affordable housing (starter homes, homes for key workers and sheltered accommodation for the elderly)	9 out of 24 plans
Improvements to street lighting.	8 out of 24 plans
