Minutes of the Meeting held on Thursday 19th February 2015 at 7.15pm in Longstowe Village Hall

Mr R Murden reported on his meeting with the Tree Landscape Officer of the SCDC: elm suckers and brambles to be cut down; oak tree needs dead-wooding; pair of elms to be removed; rest of SCDC woods to be surveyed. It was also reported that the street lighting had not been completed.

- 91 THE MINUTES OF LAST MEETING
 Minutes of 15th January 2015 were agreed and signed.
- 92 REPORTS FROM COUNCILLORS AND PCSO
 Cllr S Kindersley reported that the street lighting contract between the CCC
 and Balfour Beatty was confidential; he is attempting to get more details. He
 also reported that the CCC budget / business plan is under financial pressure
 and that by 2020 there would be no Government money for Councils. A
 1.99% increase in council tax is the maximum without an expensive
 referendum. There are demographic pressures of older people with long-term
 problems and new births. All Cllrs are involved in the budget, facing a £29m
 reduction: "the worst is still to come". Cllr Kindersley suggests a consortium of
 villages to hire a person or persons to do what is expected of the Councils.
