 The Sub-Committee has considered the application very carefully and has had due regard to the Licensing Act 2003, the accompanying Guidance and Regulations and the SCDC Licensing Policy. We have heard the evidence of the applicants in their capacity as Trustees of the Hall together with the representees present at the hearing.

The representations from the nearby residents were on the grounds of the prevention of public nuisance, namely noise from band practice and light disturbance from internal windows and fire doors.

The Panel considered the hours requested in the application for the premises open to the public were acceptable on Friday and Saturday evenings but not during the remainder of the week and modified the licence accordingly. The Panel also modified the hours for the regulated entertainment to prevent public nuisance to neighbouring residents at noise sensitive times.

The Panel attach the following conditions to the licence to address the public nuisance concerns of nearby residents:

- Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at all exits, requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.
- External doors and windows shall be kept closed during periods when there is any regulated entertainment taking place, except to allow access and egress from the premises
- A 'blackout' blind shall be installed to cover the velux window (RL10 shown on the plan accompanying the application) in the kitchen and shall be drawn during the hours of darkness

Interested parties and responsible authorities may apply for a review of the licence on a ground relating to one or more of the licensing objectives should there by any relevant issues arising from the operation of the premises licence at any stage in the future. The four licensing objectives are: the Prevention of Crime and Disorder; Prevention of Public Nuisance; Public Safety and Protection of Children from Harm.

The applicant and objectors have a right of appeal to the Cambridge Magistrates' Court within 21 days of receiving notification of this decision.
