The Sub-Committee has considered the application very carefully and has had due regard to the Licensing Act 2003, the accompanying Guidance and Regulations and

the SCDC Licensing Policy. We have read and considered the letters from the representees that were made on the basis of the prevention of public nuisance. We heard the evidence of the applicant who made some alterations and clarifications to her application at the hearing, namely the removal of all outside music and a reduction to thirty minutes of drinking up time on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays.

The application is approved and the licence granted subject to the following conditions:

- Members of the Public shall not be allowed access to the Public House after 23:00 hours.
- No outside drinking shall take place between 23:00-08:00 hours, except for a licensed outdoor entertainment event
- Bottles and other refuse shall not be placed in outside receptacles between 23:00-08:00 hours
- A clear, prominent and legible notice shall be placed adjacent to all exits requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly
- All doors and windows shall be kept shut to The Event Room (except for ingress and egress) during licensed entertainment events
- Existing conditions involving embedded restrictions from the Licensing Act 1964 and the Children and Young Persons Act 1933 were removed from the Licence.

Interested parties and responsible authorities may apply for a review of the licence on a ground relating to one or more of the licensing objectives should there be any relevant issues arising from the operation of the premises licence at any stage in the future. The four licensing objectives are: the Prevention of Crime and Disorder; Prevention of Public Nuisance; Public Safety and Protection of Children from Harm.

The applicant and objectors have a right of appeal to the Cambridge Magistrates' Court within 21 days of receiving notification of this decision.
