- 1. DRAFT SERVICE PLANS 2010/11: ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES**
The Environmental Services Portfolio Holder endorsed the draft plan to be taken forward through the Council's decision making and prioritisation processes.
- 2. COMMUNITY CLEAN-UP CAMPAIGN PLAN**
The Environmental Services Portfolio Holder **agreed** the proposals for the Community Clean Up initiative as outlined in the report.
- 3. CONSULTATION ON A STRATEGY FOR HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT IN ENGLAND**
The Environmental Services Portfolio Holder **agreed** with the RECAP response to the consultation on a strategy for hazardous waste management in England, set out in Appendix 1 to the report.
- 4. WASTE FRAMEWORK DIRECTIVE - CONSULTATION RESPONSE**
The Portfolio Holder
 - (a) endorsed the RECAP response to the Stage One consultation paper on the transposition of the revised Waste Framework Directive (Directive 2008/98/EC) outlined in this report.
 - (b) noted the approach and result of the Council's strategic review of refuse and recycling service was entirely consistent with the provisions of the revised WFD.
