Reason for Decision

Failure to adopt a revised policy will result in the Council failing in its statutory duties under the Licensing Act 2003.

2. BARRINGTON - STREET TRADING CONSENT - RESOLUTION

The Licensing Committee **AGREED** to the request by Barrington Parish Council for all streets in the village to be designated as Consent Streets.

Reason for Decision

Approving the application for Consent Street Status allows the District Council to control street trading for the village of Barrington.
