

What's the route?

Leaving the historic heart of Cambridge, you'll ride alongside the river Cam, through the stunning Cambridgeshire countryside and many breathtaking idyllic Essex villages, finishing with a 5 mile stretch along the vibrant Southend seafront.

Where and when does it start?

Start your ride any time between 7.30 – 9.00am at Jesus Green, Cambridge.

How much does it cost to enter?

Entry is **£20** and includes an event t-shirt, commemorative medal and water. Please note participants must be aged 14 and over to take part in the 74 mile route. Younger riders can join in the fun for FREE on one of the 10 mile routes.
