EXECUTIVE DECISIONS TAKEN SINCE WEDNESDAY ...



In accordance with the <u>Access to Information</u> <u>Procedure Rules in Part 4 of the Council's</u> <u>Constitution</u>, any executive decision shall be published normally within five days of being made. That record will bear the date on which it is published and will specify that the decision will come into force, and may then be implemented, on the expiry of 5 working days after the publication of the decision, unless called in for review by the Chairman of the Scrutiny and Overview Committee or by any five other councillors.

A list of decisions currently within the call-in period is available on the Council's website.

The call in procedure is set out in full in <u>Part 4 of the Council's Constitution, 'Scrutiny</u> and Overview Committee Procedure Rules'.

6. Community Led Housing - Grant Application by Histon & Impington CLT

Lead Cabinet Member for Housing **AGREED** to a approve a community-led development grant of £4,500 to Histon & Impington Community Land Trust.

This decision was first published on 1 June and so the deadline for call-in is 8 June at 5pm.
