1. Authority Monitoring Report for Greater Cambridge 2019-2020

Cabinet:

- a) **Agreed** the Cambridge City Council and South Cambridgeshire District Council - Authority Monitoring Report (AMR) for Greater Cambridge 2019-2020 (included as Appendix 1) for publication on the Councils' websites.
- b) **Delegated** any further minor editing changes to the Cambridge City Council and South Cambridgeshire District Council - AMR for Greater Cambridge 2019-2020 to the Joint Director for Greater Cambridge Shared Planning.

Options Considered: Cabinet could have:

Not published the Authority Monitoring Report for Greater Cambridge 2019-2020. However, it is a legal requirement that the Council publishes an AMR on an annual basis.

Reason for Decision: In January 2019, Cabinet agreed that a joint AMR would be produced which covers both Cambridge and South Cambridgeshire, and that these future AMRs for Greater Cambridge would be agreed for publication by the Executive Member for Planning Policy at Cambridge City Council together with the Cabinet Member for Planning at South Cambridgeshire District Council via a decision outside of a meeting. However, at the Cambridge Planning and Transport Scrutiny Committee meeting in September 2020 a request was made for the next AMR for Greater Cambridge to be considered at a meeting rather than through a decision outside of a meeting.

2. Update on Health and Wellbeing Strategy

Cabinet:

Noted the contents of the report and considered the impacts of Covid on the delivery of activities and services which promote physical and mental health and wellbeing.

Options Considered: Cabinet could have:

Not approved the update on the Health and Wellbeing Strategy.

Reason for Decision: It was agreed by Cabinet in June 2020, that the strategy would be an active working document to be reviewed at 6 months and 3 yearly thereafter.
