**2. Update: M11 Junction 9 to 10: Bridge Repairs**

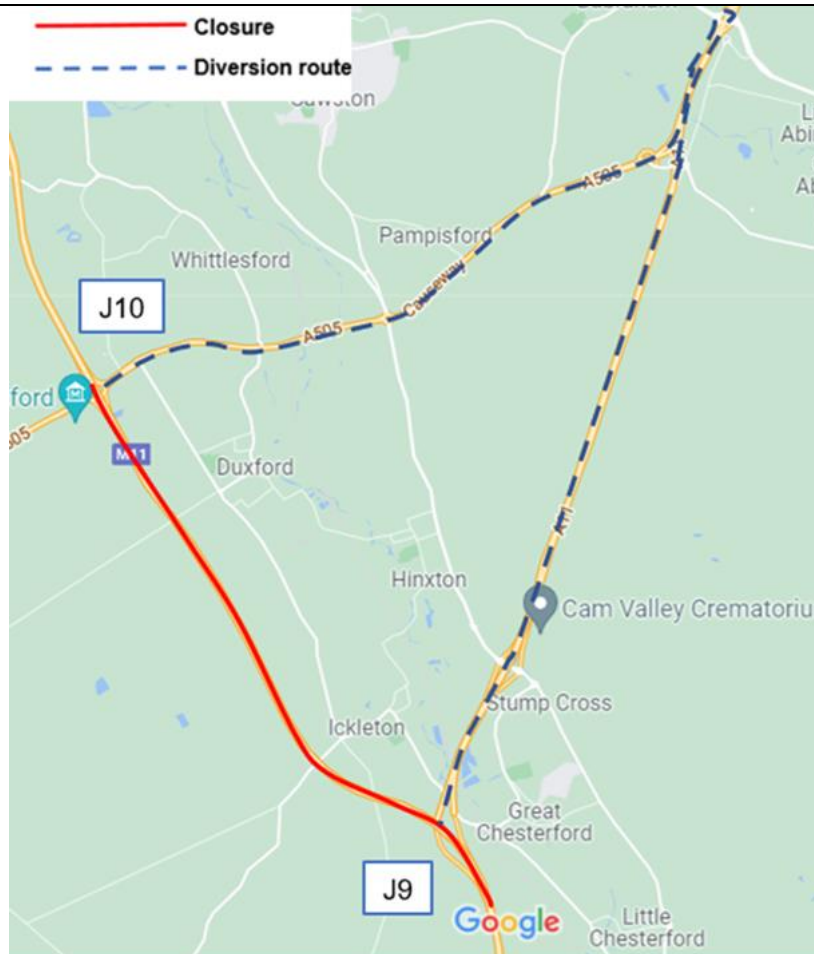
National Highways are continuing their work to replace the expansion joints, re-waterproof and resurface the M11 junction 9 overbridge. This work will ensure the bridge continues to remain in a safe and serviceable condition.

The plan is to complete this work over **1 weekend** from **Friday 27 May**, weather conditions permitting.

Traffic will be diverted as follows:

- **M11 junction 10 to 9 southbound, full closure**  
Friday 27 May, 9pm to Monday 30 May, 5am

Southbound traffic will be diverted off the M11 at junction 10 onto the A505 / A11. Exit the A11 using the A1307 slip road and return onto the A11 southbound to re-join the M11 at junction 9. Northbound traffic will follow the same diversion but in reverse.

Issues have been reported with the Homes for Ukraine scheme, with refugees being left homeless as relationships with host families in the UK break down, community groups have warned.

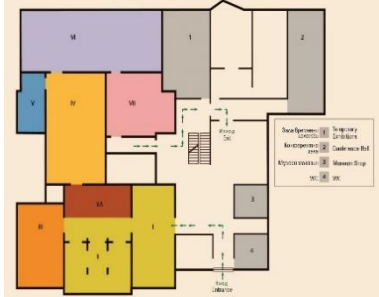

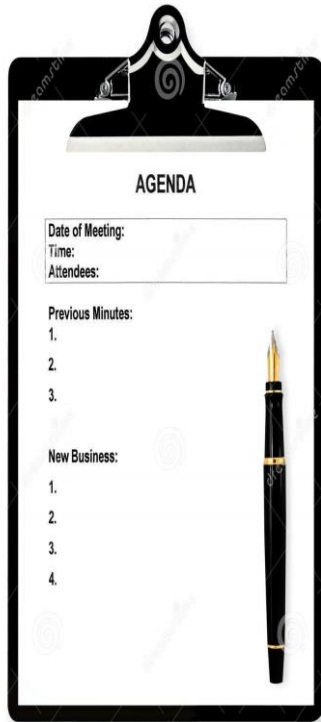
