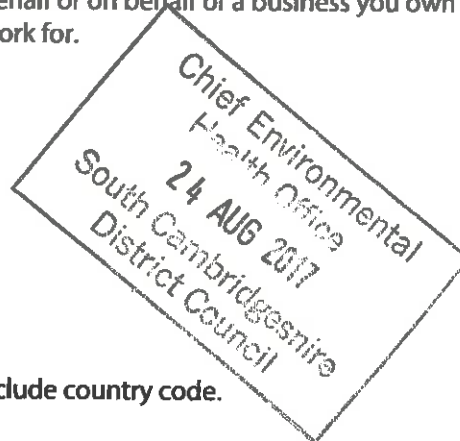

Display sign requesting staff/customers to leave quietly from the premises

Reduce the level of music or play calmer music towards the end of the night

Carry out regular checks to ensure that music is played to an acceptable level whilst taking into consideration our neighbours

Delivery of goods to be carried out at appropriate hours of the day to protect the local residents from noise disturbance

The movement of rubbish and bin bags will be kept to a minimum after 11pm or not carried out until the following morning

Any lighting outside the premises will be directed so as to not affect the local residents but to still provide safety to the public when leaving the premises
