I am writing to strongly object to the request for a new premises licence referenced above.

My house, which is in a conservation area, is adjacent to the premises in question (in fact my garden shares a boundary with the café) and I am concerned that if this licence is granted it could lead to unacceptable levels of noise and disturbance from customers who could potentially be drinking alcohol late into the evening. The request is to allow alcohol to be served until 11.30pm seven days a week. Since Church Street already has two public houses and a licenced Indian restaurant I feel that restricted licencing hours would be far more considerate for neighbours of the café.

I am also concerned about the impact on the environment, i.e. an increase in the number of customers is very likely to lead to problems with rats due to food waste, and will also have a negative impact on traffic and parking, which is already a major problem in Gamlingay.
