Subject	Decision	Reasons
To consider extending the period of a historic building grant offer approved in October 2004 by 12 months, for rethatching in longstraw at The Barn, High Street, Great Eversden for Cambridgeshire Cottage Housing Society.	To extend the period of the grant of £4305 to Cambridgeshire Cottage Housing Society for the rethatching of The Barn, High Street Great Eversden by a period of 12 months expiring on the 31 st October 2006.	A grant would meet the aims of the grant policy, encourage the use of local materials, and enhance the appearance of this historic building. The extended period will allow the essential works of repair and restoration to a dwelling to be implemented before the rethatching works take place.

Bassingbourn/Melbourn Village Colleges (ADU03)	Agreed to award a Dual Use Arts Grant of £10,000 to support the work of the arts development manager to build upon the arts services provided within the District.
