To extend the period of the grant of £4305 to Cambridgeshire Cottage Housing Society for the rethatching of The Barn, High Street Great Eversden by a period of 12 months expiring on the 31 <sup>st</sup> October 2006.	A grant would meet the aims of the grant policy, encourage the use of local materials, and enhance the appearance of this historic building. The extended period will allow the essential works of repair and restoration to a dwelling to be implemented before the rethatching works take place.
