Dear Sirs

Thank you for your response to my email. We would like to object on grounds of prevention of public nuisance and crime and disorder.

We wish to raise an objection to this proposal on the grounds that School Lane is a residential area and the position of this property (the first house in the lane hidden behind high fence just off the A10) is not well suited to comings and goings of people collecting alcohol. This kind of activity should be utilising a site on one of the trading estates. Online purchase of alcohol is available to anyone with internet and a credit card so why introduce a 'middle service' that increases traffic at a difficult junction?

Notwithstanding the fact that the pubs are closed at the moment, the area is still well served for purchasing alcohol - Tesco Milton, One Stop Milton and Waterbeach and the off licence at the petrol station adjacent to the Research Park are all within a 5 mile radius. The vast piles of discarded beer cans littering the bus stop are evidence of this. I can't imagine who drinks in the bus stop at this relatively isolated location but having alcohol available just round the corner is likely to exacerbate this anti-social behaviour and is not to be encouraged.
