

## APPENDIX D

Good Morning,

I am an Immigration officer and last night we visited Tamarind Indian Cuisine at 1 High Street, Teversham CB1 9AS,

Upon arrival at the restaurant two members of staff ran from the premises and were not apprehended. A third person was the only member of staff left on site. Further investigations revealed him to be an Immigration Offender and he was subsequently arrested.

We noticed there was a handwritten sign in the window stating they are not allowed to sell alcohol at present which was next to another sign which gave notice that an alcohol license has been applied for. This sign stated that the license application hearing is on 12<sup>th</sup> March 2020.

Immigration and Enforcement would like to strongly oppose the granting of a new license on the following grounds.

- 1) They had no staff there who were legally allowed to work in the UK.
- 2) The owner of the business and license applicant is called Ruhel Ahmed and was not present. Furthermore the member of staff interviewed did not appear to know how to contact him in an emergency
- 3) There are numerous other concerns which I am reporting separately to Environmental Health regarding possible Health, Safety and Hygiene breaches as well as concerns I shall raise with Cambridgeshire Fire Service regarding the living accommodation above that does not appear to meet basic fire safety standards.
