Representation Memo to Licensing re: Premises Licence Application: Tamarind Indian Cuisine, 1 High St, Teversham, Cambridgeshire, CB1 9AS

I have reviewed the Premises Licence Application and from an Environmental Health point of view, I have the following comments:

I am not aware of any records of formal complaints having been made to this department in relation to noise nuisance or the licensable activities at these premises. However, I have reviewed the operating schedule within Section 18 of the premises licence application form and my view is that there are additional steps which, if incorporated into the premises licence conditions, in addition to those stated in Section 18 of the application form, would improve the promotion of the licensing objectives.

As such I am making a representation in relation to the Prevention of Public Nuisance, Public Safety and the Protection of Children from Harm.

In addition, I have noticed that on the premises licence application form, the applicant has ticked to say he will not be providing late night refreshment, however the premises could remain open to the public until 23:30 on Monday-Wednesday, 23:59 on Sunday and 00:30 on Thursday- Saturday. As such, I would suggest it is a likely possibility that customers will expect to be served hot drinks, if not hot food, between 23:00 and the premises' closing time.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

1. Ensure prominent, clear and legible notices are displayed at all exits to the premises, and in the car park, requesting users to respect the needs of neighbours and to leave the premises and area quietly and in a timely manner.
2. Ensure that there is no movement of alcohol related refuse, including bottles, refuse bins, or other related equipment outside the building at the premises, unless in an emergency, between 22:00 and 07:00 hours.
3. Dray, and other related, deliveries or collections shall not take place between the hours of 22:00- 07:00 hours.
4. Any external lighting shall be directed away from neighbouring properties and lit only during operational hours.
5. All premises' doors and windows shall be kept closed between 22:00- 07:00 hours, except to allow for access and egress from the premises or in emergencies.
6. If providing an outdoor smoking area, it is to be located away from any noise sensitive neighbouring properties.

Public Safety

7. Ensure a log book is kept at the premises which shall include each and every occasion, identifying the date and time, where there has been any refusal to sell alcohol and/ or any antisocial behaviour relating to alcohol sales
8. Ensure all safety certificates and inspection reports are kept at the premises and made available to authorised officers of relevant statutory organisations.

Protection of Children from Harm

9. Ensure that all children are accompanied at all times during those hours when the premises is open for alcohol sales for consumption on the premises.

It is Environmental Health's opinion that the inclusion of the above conditions will assist in promoting the licensing objectives.
