Notice is hereby given that Greene King Retailing Limited has applied in respect of the Waggon & Horses, 110 High Street, Linton, CB21 4JT for a variation to the premises licence under the Licensing Act 2003 to allow for: This is an application to vary the layout and design of the premises in accordance with the submitted plan. The changes include the addition of a marquee in the external area, an additional lawn area and conversion of a store room into a serving hatch. To remove the following conditions:
3. No outside drinking shall take place between 23.00 and 08.00

9. The designated premises supervisor or nominated representative shall carry out an hourly noise assessment at the boundary of the premises whilst regulated entertainment events are taking place, in order to check that there is no noise nuisance arising from the regulated entertainment.

To add the following conditions to the premises licence:

- No outside drinking shall take place between 00.00 and 08.00

- When regulated entertainment is provided in the external areas of the premises, noise checks will be carried out at the nearest noise sensitive property. A noise check log ('the log') of these checks will be kept and maintained at the premises. As a maximum the log will record the date and time of the check, the name of the person making the check, the sound level and if required, any action taken. The log will be made available to an authorised officer upon request. Representations to this application must be made in writing, by the end of 23 October 2020, to the South Cambridgeshire District Council Licensing Authority at South Cambridgeshire Hall, Cambourne Business Park, Cambourne, Cambridgeshire, CB23 6EA where the register of licensing applications can be inspected during office hours.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with this application. Persons will be liable on summary conviction to an unlimited fine.
