Urgent Executive Decisions

Purpose

1. To provide an information report on an Executive decision which was exempted from call-in under Scrutiny and Overview Procedure Rules 13.19 – 13.21.

Background

4. Rule 13.19 of the Scrutiny and Overview Procedure Rules in the Council's Constitution provides that the call-in procedure shall not apply where the decision being taken by the executive decision taker is urgent. A decision is urgent if any delay likely to be caused by the call-in process would seriously prejudice the Council's or the public's interests. The Chairman of the Council and the Chairman of the Scrutiny and Overview Committee must both agree that the decision proposed is reasonable in all the circumstances and to it being treated as a matter of urgency.
5. Rule 13.20 provides that decisions taken as a matter of urgency must be reported to the next available meeting of the Council, together with the reasons for the urgency.
