

Officer Summary	<p>Waterbeach Military Heritage Museum is a museum covering RAF Waterbeach from 1939 to 1966 and Royal Engineers from 1966 to 2013. It has a self-admittedly haphazard paper record keeping of the collection which goes back to the original museum in 1984. This application is to allow the museum to move over to a digital system by purchasing a laptop and industry standard museum record keeping software (MODES). This will enable them to record the donor of the object, the ownership, a description with photograph, object number and its location within the museum. Also the laptop will aid large grant applications from Lottery and other grant giving bodies. In turn we would be able to update the displays, security and the visitor experience for instance. WMHM Is funding £500 towards this project and has also going to make an application to Waterbeach Parish Council.</p> <p>The building will remain open as part of Urban &amp; Civic's S106 planning conditions.</p>

Officer Summary			

Blue Smile is a registered charity providing expert arts-based therapy to children aged 3-13 years working across Cambridgeshire. They work with children who have mental health or emotional problems, and provide free long-term expert therapy to their families. Blue Smile report that 94% of parents say they feel their child's mental health has improved as a result of their work.

During the first lockdown they issued therapeutic art packs (funded by Cambridgeshire community foundation) to the children they were previously seeing in face to face therapy, to be used in online therapy or in phone discussions with therapists. Children can also keep their artwork to show their therapist once face to face therapy can resume. According to Blue Smile one of their therapists said, "One family have nothing the art pack is all they have" and "a parent said that the pack had helped their child to make a bridge between the sessions (or lack of them during lock down) and home. They said that their child had not previously spontaneously drawn using their imagination at home but used the Blue Smile pack to do this."

This application will part-fund the South Cambs fraction of approximately 150 art packs to children across the county. An application has been made for the proportion of children in East Cambs. The packs contain items such as coloured paper and card, paints and brushes, pencils, crayons, glue and craft materials such as feathers or pipe cleaners. These are supplied free of charge via the school that the child usually attends. The children who receive them are recognised as having mental health difficulties. 56% of children so helped are recognised as disadvantaged. 48% have Special Educational Needs and Disabilities. They are therefore supplied to some of the most needy children in the region.
