The Prevention of Public Nuisance

We wish to strongly object to the proposed Premises Licence Variation for The Lodge, Duxford. The level of noise that is created with such a large outside space is bad enough just with just people sitting outside without the addition of music/entertainment until midnight. They had a function outside on Sat 5 Feb and the excessive noise created could be heard inside our house. My daughters bedroom is on the Ickleton Road side and she complained about the noise throughout the night and when people were leaving the Hotel. The noise and disturbance in a residential area is totally unacceptable. The sound travels acrosss the road to all of our houses and it completely spoils the peace of sitting in your own garden in a quiet village. This is a lovely boutique hotel which we are happy to have in Duxford but they need to respect the villagers. We have lived here for 29 years and have never had to make a complaint so hope that our views will be respected.

Public Safety

This is probably our biggest issue with parking at the Lodge. There are not enough spaces inside the property causing parking outside, on the road and edge of pavement, Sat 5th Feb a prime example of an accident waiting to happen. Cars park down Ickleton Road close to the bend, cars park overnight half on the pavement, it is just so dangerous. With bigger events there will be more cars parking on our road and around the village, which again is totally unacceptable. I hope this does not take an accident to happen to turn down this Licence Application.
