## **Background**

3. The ICT Security Policy and Usage guidelines were originally drafted in April 2001 with subsequent revisions in 2002 and 2003. The return to an in-house supported provision for ICT services has required a number of changes to the systems employed. The ICT Security Policy and Usage guidelines have been reviewed to reflect those charges.

#### **Considerations**

- 4. Review of the guidelines is a requirement to ensure compliance with good practice and current legislation. The policy is designed to protect both the Council and its staff (the user).
- 5. Failure to update the policy in line with system and/or service changes could lead to exposures which may have an impact on the ability of the Council to conduct it's business.
- 6. The policy forms the framework under which all access (internal and external) to ICT systems is governed. The Councils dependencies on electronic systems and services demand a robust usage policy.
