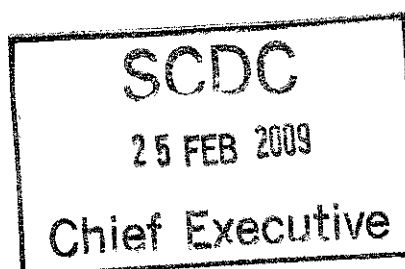


Dispensation for Barrington Parish Council

Dispensation for Barrington Parish Council

On the advice of Fiona McMillan, I am writing to you to request a Dispensation for Barrington Parish Council. I understand that there is no longer a Form to complete and that a letter to you is what is required which would be presented to the Standards Board.

Barrington Parish Council is the Custodian Trustee for The Green Charity Barrington, Registered Number 205227. The Dispensation is required for 4 years, or the elected period of the incoming Council as from 09.05.07. It would be best if the Dispensation were to be given for the duration of Parish Council, rather than for 4 years, in case the timescale were to be changed again.
