Friends of St Vigors, Fulbourn	To award a £250 Arts Guarantee Against Loss Grant (AGAL13) from the 2003/04 budget for an Easter concert on April 21 st 2003	Friends of St Vigors promote high quality music events, which attract large audiences from Fulbourn and the surrounding area.
