TRAVELLERS' ISSUES UPDATE

Purpose

1. To update the Housing Portfolio Holder regarding grant funding to upgrade the Gypsy and Travellers site at Blackwell Farm, Milton.

Background

- 3. The site is owned by Cambridgeshire County Council and is managed by this Council.
- 4. The Homes and Communities Agency invited bids from across the region for the improvement of Gypsy and Traveller sites. A bid was submitted by the Council to the HCA on behalf of the County Council.
- 5. The Council has now been informed that it has been successful in its bid and subject to conditions; it will receive funding to enable the refurbishment of the site units and infrastructure. The total value of the grant is £894,000.

Considerations

- 6. Cambridgeshire County Council has appointed a project manager to oversee the work required.
- 7. Residents will be fully consulted and kept informed throughout the duration of the work and the County will continue to work in partnership with the Council.
- 8. Work will start on site following a planning application to be made in February 2011 and completion of the project is expected by December 2011.
