#### **CDRP FUNDING 2011-12**

#### **Purpose**

1. To update the CDRP Board on progress with 2011-12 funding.

## **Background**

2. In 2011-12 the CDRP received funding as follows:

## Safer & Stronger Communities Fund (SSCF)

 £41,915 in SSCF funding was received. This is a reduction of 30% compared with SSCF funding in 2010-11. This funding was used to employ the Partnership Support Officer and ASB Caseworker.

#### **CDRP Pooled Fund**

£26,272 available. There will be no contributions to the Pooled Fund in 2011-12.
 The Pooled Fund does not need to be spent by the end of the financial year.

# 3. **Potential Future Funding**

Requests for funding in the future may include:

- 3.1 Transport for victims of domestic abuse to attend SARC (Sexual Assault Referral Centre) in Peterborough.
- 3.2 Running a programme in Cambourne to reduce increasing levels of domestic abuse.
- 3.3 Funding to Cambridge Mediation Service to refer cases of neighbour disputes and ASB.
