Housing Capital Expenditure: Housing Strategy and Investment Programmes 1978/79 to 1981/82

- 1. That the Council expresses its concern about the delay which has already occurred in the provision of additional local authority housing in smaller villages and whilst noting that in some cases this is due partly to the non-availability of main drainage, is of the opinion that steps should be taken to overcome such problems.






I herewith give Notice of the following motion that I wish to propose at the next Meeting of the Council; -
