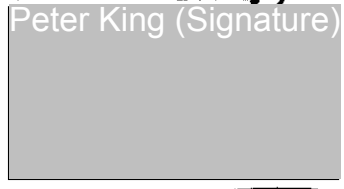
NOTICE OF MOTION.
