- 113 THE MINUTES OF LAST MEETING  
Minutes of 27th March 2014 were agreed and signed.
- 114 REPORTS FROM COUNCILLORS  
Cllr B Smith: SCDC has approved the Local Plan and sent it to the Planning Inspector: it includes 19,000 new houses to be built in Cambourn West (Caxton) and Bourn Airfield by 2013. Cambridge has received £500m for infrastructure. Cambs School funding: increase in pupil premium. Cambridge Park&Ride will charge £1 for up to 18 hours parking (one hour free to pick-up and drop-off). Geensands LAG (European funding for rural areas): new grants available for a share of £140million: possible funding for the Village Hall?  
Cllr S Kindersley: Longstowe speed limit: the Parish Council were advised to insist on the original agreement. There will be a Sunday bus service between Cambridge and Gamlingay in the summer.
