Anglian Water: about nine months ago they renewed manhole covers opposite nos 33 & 22 High Street: they have been badly fitted and clatter; this has been reported resulting in two men in two vans visiting the site but nothing has been done. Diseased trees in Rushbrook Close on SCDC land: Mr R Murden meeting with new Tree Officer in February. Flooding at St John's Farm is still a problem.
