## **ERRATUM**

Medium Term Financial Strategy, General Fund Budget 2017-18 (including council tax setting), Housing Revenue Account Budget 2017-18 (including housing rents), Capital Programme and Treasury Management Strategy

## **Purpose**

- Council are asked to acknowledge a drafting error in respect of recommendation (m) in the covering report for the Medium Term Financial Strategy, General Fund Budget 2017-18 (including council tax setting), Housing Revenue Account Budget 2017-18 (including housing rents), Capital Programme and Treasury Management Strategy.
- 2. The HRA Budget Setting Report has been constructed on the basis that garage rents will increase by 1.9% from April 2017, in line with the base rate of inflation assumed for 2017/18 in the business plan. Appendix A to the HRA Budget Setting Report confirms that the base rate of inflation assumed in the HRA budget process is 1.9% for 2017/18, rising to 2.4% from 2018/19. Table B to the HRA Budget Setting Report confirms the resulting increased garage rents from April 2017, once the 1.9% inflationary increase has been applied. The result of this increase has been incorporated into budgets and financial forecasts.
- 3. In drafting the covering report, presented to Scrutiny and Cabinet, the figure of 2.4% was incorrectly presented at recommendation (m), instead of the correct inflationary percentage of 1.9%.
- As a result of this drafting error, Council are asked to replace the original recommendation (m) in the report to Council, with an amended recommendation (m) as detailed below.

## **Amended Recommendation**

1 Council are asked to:-

## **Review of Rents and Charges**

(m) Approve inflationary increases of 1.9% in garage rents for 2017-18, in line with the base rate of inflation for the year assumed in the HRA Budget Setting Report.

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
